

# Project LIFT

By the end of 2018, more than **400** victims of domestic and sexual violence will have received legal representation from certified attorneys through the LIFT program.



- A core of approximately 20 attorneys in the Colorado Springs metro area works with TESSA to provide legal representation.
- These attorneys represent clients in permanent protective orders hearings.
- As a result of the program, more protective orders have been granted.
- Victims also report feeling safer and more supported by working with an attorney.
- LIFT attorneys report giving victims advice about other matters including divorce, child custody, employment, housing, and other legal issues that survivors face.
